5) Legal Update - Brad Banasik

State Budget update

2020 FY \$1.5 billion shortfall = \$685 per pupil cut for school districts

Proration is possible

State Fiscal year (Oct 1) is not the same as school districts (July 1)

Still holding out for federal government funding

(Supplemental bill = \$25b for computers and tablets - not for budget shortfall)

Governor's return to school plan due June 30

Screening for temperature is a best practice from MHSAA not a mandatory requirement from Executive orders. Temperature screening by school staff is not a HIPAA concern. Does not apply to educational records. FERPA is the concern.

New Title IX guidelines go into effect on August 14

Updated Definition of Sexual Harassment

Existing regulations regarding athletic participation were not affected

Actual Knowledge is defined to any employee - includes coaches

<u>Post Secondary</u> coaches are not required to be mandatory reporters. K-12 are not excluded and are mandatory reporters.

Title VII case issued 6/15, Sexual Orientation and Gender identity has application to Title IX

Dissent by Justice Alito Regarding transgender athletes, Alito referred to the Connecticut case and said the question under Title IX "threatens to undermine one of that law's major achievements, giving young women an equal opportunity to participate in sports."

"The effect of the court's reasoning may be to force young women to compete against students who have a very significant biological advantage, including students who have



the size and strength of a male but identify as female and students who are taking male hormones in order to transition from female to male," Alito continued.
