- PA 184: Retires from public school reporting unit, 9 month period, after 9 months, full salary allowed while pulling pension
- HB 4752: less than 10K during 9 month period-still not approved
- Winter & Spring fix (thinking September)
- Fall coaches (could be a concern)

Pushing for immediate effect

#### NIL

- Name, Image, and Likeness- right to publicize themselves
- Video- shoot Uyl an email
- College: billions and millions of dollars (student-athletes get a piece of the action)
- Concerns: NIL collectives should not happen
- Individual opportunities, narrowly allowed rule for individuals
- Currently, 21-28 states allow for HS NIL

# 5) <u>Legal Update</u> - Brad Banasik

- -4305 & 250: \$10,000 limit in a calendar year, no action yet, hearing no traction because it singled out specific positions (coaches and sports officials)
- -House Bill 4752: introduced on June 14, 2023 by the Chair of the Committee- doesn't refer to any position, just the limitation of \$10K or less- better chance/best practice: make sure there aren't conversations around the former "coach" being the new "coach", must be a separation, no "promise of the job". Advice is to post the job, allow them to apply, don't just "hand" it over to the retiree
- -HB 4816 NIL Bill: HS athletes to receive compensation for NIL, it is up for discussion
- -Constitutionally Protected Prayer- "When teachers, **coaches**, and other public school officials speak in their official capacities, they may not engage in prayer or promote religious views
- -Title IX Rulemaking- timeline is Oct 2023- should have a year to adjust
- -Dress Code violations- Keep an eye on Title 9, wording should be general, try to keep referrals equal for genders
